	Phone: Hycroft Manor was built by General Alexander Duncan McRae between 1907 and 1911. In 1942, the McRaes donated Hycroft Manor to the Canadian Government. It was
	repurposed by the Federal Department of Veterans' Affairs as a convalescent hospital for war veterans. In 1962, the University Women's Club of Vancouver (UWCV) purchased the property and soon restored the manor to its former glory, but the gardens were in a terrible state of decay. The gardens that exist today at Hycroft reflect the work of Hycroft Garden Club members since 1963. It is a very beautiful and particularly unique because of the number and variety of heritage trees on the property including a giant sequoia, purple beech, citrus atlanticus, black walnut, poplars, magnolia and rhododendrons. The mandate of the Hycroft Garden committee is to restore, maintain and retain the garden features with the Edwardian Garden scheme in view.
